

AUSTRALIA DAY 2011 - CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

General Conditions

Parramatta City Council (PCC) advises that for the comfort, safety and enjoyment of all attendees it:

- reserves the right to refuse entry to attendees deemed to be intoxicated, disorderly, or who do not comply with a request to conduct a bag/wand search
- reserves the right to inspect bags of all attendees who enter/leave the event. This may include the touching of the outside of the bag and/or seeking assistance of the bag owner to remove items from the bag
- advises that attendees bringing personal items into the event do so at their own risk. PCC will not be held responsible for any damage to, loss or theft of an attendees personal property
- advises that unauthorised soliciting and customer surveying is not permitted
- advised that sitting on shoulders, crowd surfing, heavy moshing and slam dancing are not permitted during the concert
- advises that attendees who cause a disturbance or exhibit anti-social behaviour will be reported to Police

Restricted/Prohibited Items

PCC advises that the following items are not permitted to be brought into the event and can be cloaked in the Storage Tent adjacent to the Main Entry:

- glass bottles (including wine glasses and jars)
- illegal substances
- air horns
- laser pointers
- items that are deemed to be possible missiles or weapons (including knives)
- commercial fast foods
- musical instruments
- large backpacks, oversized bags/eskies
- tables, tents or sun shelters
- disposable BBQ's
- animals (except guide dogs)
- clothing with offensive wording, pictures, or graphic design
- megaphones/loud-hailers
- poles, sticks or oversized flags (maximum 1m x 1m)
- fireworks, flares and explosives
- professional photographic, video and audio recording equipment
- balls, frisbees, bicycles, skateboards, crash helmets, scooters and rollerskates
- confetti or shredded paper
- any other item that PCC considers inappropriate

PLEASE NOTE: Stored items can be reclaimed within one hour of the end of the event. Unclaimed property will be disposed of by PCC and no further claims may be made. PCC and Parramatta Park Trust, their staff and contractors accept no responsibility for stored property.

Liquor Licensing

PCC advised all attendees entering the event that:

- attendees deemed to be on the verge of intoxication will be reported to Police
- it is an offence to supply minors with alcohol and also for minors to consume alcohol. Penalties apply under the Liquor Act 2007.
