All Australians are invited to nominate a member of the community whose exemplary contribution is deserving of recognition; this could be a friend, family member, workmate or someone you have met while serving the community.

Recipients of the Australia Day Awards are selected according to a range of criteria; including the type and level of service, scholarly achievement, sporting achievement, or individual acts of excellence or generosity.

Service may have been in any appropriate field where an active concern for the rights, welfare or advancement of others has been demonstrated.

AWARD CATEGORIES

- **Senior Citizen of the Year** – 60 years and over
- **Citizen of the Year** – 22 to 59 years
- **Young Citizen of the Year** - Up to 21 years
- **Sportsperson of the Year** – Open
- **Community Project of the Year** - Any project held in 2010 that benefits the community of Parramatta. The event/project must be coordinated by a local community organisation based in the Parramatta Local Government Area
